Four years ago we added a 70' flag pole with a 15' X 25' flag at the Land Title Plaza, 1st & Main Streets, dedicated to all veterans. This flag has been regularly cleaned, repaired and replaced as needed in keeping with our beautiful award winning Downtown Walla Walla. This year we have began exploring the possibility refurbishing the Wainwright Memorial located on the historic parade grounds at the Jonathan M. Wainwright Memorial VA Medical Center by replacing the flag pole located at the site with one similar in size and stature as the downtown flag pole.
